

displacement of the tumblers, has at the front end an inclined surface, which, when the key is introduced into the locking cylinder, raises the lugs of the tumbler strips and introduces them into the lateral cam grooves, at the same time bringing the supplementary protective member into the opening position.

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10 7. A lock as claimed in claims 5 and 6, characterised by the feature that in the

key, besides the lateral cam grooves, a guiding groove is provided, in which the guiding rib on the locking cylinder engages when the key is introduced.

8. A lock, substantially as hereinbefore described with reference to the accompanying drawings. 15
